Member Naaman Woodland sent in the following article & chart - of interest to Union County folks: (Professor Woodland is on the faculty of Lamar University, Beaumont, Texas and attended the dedication of The John E. Gray Institute 27 June 1981.)

The Beaumont Journal 25 June 1981 headlines the dedication by Vice President George Bush and his wife Barbara Pierce Bush. "Naaman Woodland, associate professor of history, and Barbara Pierce Bush, wife of vice president, trace the same genealogical line back to 1340 in England. The family immigrated to this country in the 1630's to as Puritans. "We are related through our mothers' side of the family Genealogically speaking, we would be third cousins. Mrs. Bush and I have the same great-great-grandparents, Daniel Coe and Mary Gladden. Coe," Woodland says.

The professor and Mrs. Bush have been corresponding for over a year. He says, "She is very nice about writing, but all of her notes are quick, saying, 'Dashing off to Japan, will write more later,' We are on a first name basis now," he added. "When she first started writing, it was 'Dear professor.' Then it became 'Dear cousin,' Then it became just Naaman."

Woodland has only known about the family connection for a few years. "Another cousin of mine, also related to Mrs. Bush, casually mentioned in a letter that Barbara Pierce was married to another Texan, George Bush. I thought that was rather general information, not really good in tracing genealogy. It didn't occur to me that the George Bush mentioned was THAT George Bush," Woodland explained. His first personal contact with the vice president's wife also came through a round-about route. Every semester, Woodland takes his history class to Bayou Bond in Houston. He was on a tour of the Ima Hogg home and "told his story" to one of the docents, She had been a neighbor of the Bush family in Houston and knew Mrs. Bush was interested in genealogy. The docent suggested Woodland contact his "cousin," Woodland, saying he now has "Genealogy Pox" (continual complaint as to need for names, dates and places...the sicker the patient gets, the more he enjoys it), has been working on his family tree for give years.

He is even using the "roots" approach in teaching history to some of his classes. "There is a great search for identity among young people. When they take this family approach to history, a whole new awareness happens. All of a sudden history relates personally to them and they become more interested in the subject."

(The article goes on. to name the awards for community service Professor Woodland has received from Lamar University and Beaumont community then-) Woodland says, "Making new friends is just one of the rewards of genealogical research. Seeing the same names come down through generations is exciting also." Woodland's and Mrs. Bush's family history centers in Ohio, although she was born in Rye, N.Y.

He has not sent his cousin all of the information he has on the family line, because, he said, 'it takes up two or three file cabinets.' "Of course we are lucky. The Coes were educated and they were also Puritans - and the Puritans were good record-keepers. That made it easy to tie all of this together," Woodland said.

Naaman tells in his letter that they met for the first time at the dedication and that Barbara Bush is a delightful person to have as a cousin.

An interesting item came to light the other day - a manuscript in the Plain City Public Library - THE CAPTIVITY OF JONATHAN ALDER & HIS LIFE WITH THE INDIANS as dictated by him & transcribed by his son Henry.

Many of the items of interest have been used by Howe in his HISTORICAL COLLECTIONS OF OHIO (copyright 1888) while this manuscript contains more about the family and its descendants.

Jonathan Alder, born in Maryland 17 Sept 1773 was seven years old when captured by the Indians in Virginia. He was eventually placed with the Mingo Indians. When his foster parents died he built a cabin on Big Darby Creek near what is now the Madison - Union County line. In his early 30's Jonathan Alder found his mother still living and other members of the family living in Virginia. In 1806 Jonathan married Mary Blont the daughter of Adam and brought the family back to Ohio to live. Jonathan & Mary raised 12 children - we know most of their names but not what happened to some of them. This manuscript has traced a great many of the descendents so if you find you have traced yourself back to any of them - there is a raft of material in this manuscript for you. of Madison County, Ohio) a Forqus Graham of Va. married Elizabeth Trimble, emigrated  
to KY, then to Pickaway Co, Ohio & in 1807 to Madison Co. where he lived over 50 yrs &  
then moved to Indiana. Had 12 children - 8 moved west - of the others - Robert married  
Anna Davidson & had 8 children - one of which was William H.H. Graham. Still do not  
know where the stone belongs - do you?

Then - telling the above story the other day I was asked if I had seen the  
tombstones leaning against the back of the Court House in Marysville. On west Fifth  
Street a new building is going up & the earth moving equipment uncovered this  
DR. IRA WOOD died 7 Sept 1839, age 40 yrs-5mos-20 days.  
ISABEL H. daug of Ira & Margaret Wood died 11 Apr 1852 (broken)-22 d.

Page 157 of the Union County History by Beers give the account of  
Dr. Wood - a most prominent citizen in Marysville and the same Ira  
Wood that as Justice of the Peace married a lot of the early couples.

12 April 1808 a WILL was written Codicil added April 26th 1808 and the will & codicil proven 13 June 1808 in General Court at the Capitol in Richmond, Virginia. The Will of ROBERT MEANS signed, sealed & published in presence of William Young & Edward C. Davis.

An Abstract -I Robert Means of the City of Richmond in the State of Virginia ... this my last will & testament. I direct ... all my lands tenements & real estate whatsoever & wheresoever in the whole world to Daniel Call of the City of Richmond, attorney at law .... in trust that the same may be sold & proceeds applied as herein indicated. Daniel Call & my friend John Grayham of Richmond executors, 1st to take 15% of the gross sales as their compensation, 2nd to pay themselves for all other expenses incurred upon account of my estate. 3rd \$500 to John Graham & a suit of best black broad cloth as a mark of my respect for him. 4th to pay Daniel Call \$500 and a suit of best black broad cloth ...5th pay Betty Roper of the town of Billeymoney, Anthim in the Kingdom of Ireland \$600. 6th - pay to Patrick's Boys of Fruithill of the County of Derry in the Kingdom of Ireland, \$300. Balance of said monies invest in stock of any public funds or Bank within the U.S.

I give to Margaret Morris \$300 yearly for her natural life free of debts or controul of any husband of hers. I give my honored mother Jane Means of Cobrain in the North of Ireland \$500 yearly for life. The principal of said stock to be divided into 4 equal parts to be disposed of as follows' 1st interest & dividends less 5% for executors, to my sister Nancy Maxwell free of control or debts of her husband as maintenance & education of her children. At her death & children of age - the principal to be divided equally. 2nd fourth - same conditions - to may brother William Means & to his children. 3rd fourth (same conditions) - to my brother George Means & children. 4th fourth (same conditions) to my sister Elizabeth Means of Colrain 5.n North of Ireland & her children. But if Nancy Maxwell, William Means & Elizabeth Means should die with out survivor 1/3 part to the children of my Uncle Joseph Manary late of Town of Belfast. Ireland, as shall remove to the U.S. of A. & take steps to become citizens thereof. 2nd part of three parts to the children of my uncle David Manary as be come citizens of U.S. 3rd part divided between the children who become U.S. citizens of my relations George Means & John Means of the Town of Colrain in the north of Ireland.

If my executors should depart this life I substitute Robert Gordon & George Fisher of Richmond or the survivor of them as executors of this will with the same commissions. My negro woman Patty, my household & Kitchen furniture, liquors & salted provisions to Margaret Morris.

Codicil - ... all legacees mentioned in my will except the annuities to my Mother and to Margaret Morris shall remain unpaid until my brothers and sisters in the will named shall have received annually four hundred dollars each out of the dividends or interest.

Ask the court not to require bond of executors higher than \$30,000.

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This Robert Means picked up thousands of acres in the Virginia Military tract during his dealings both in Washington D.C. and Richmond Va. He had folks out tracking down the officers entitled to land and either buying out their share or offering to survey the land for a half share. More of this later.

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Fires in Court Houses have broken many a researcher's determination and spirit so it was with great joy that the missing estate records for 1830 and to 1857 (I hope I am right on that date) that were lost in a fire - (so folks said) were found just recently and will soon be indexed and available. The little gal that is digging out the Probate records where ever stored in the Court House - is finding many choice items that have been lost over the years. One of the items- - - little slips of paper found between pages & here & there which turned out to be permission slips signed by a parent of the bride to be and submitted to the Clerk when the license was issued. It will be a job getting the permission slips with the right license.

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Another item - the Probate Court has come up with over 200 books of records that they feel are duplicates of info already recorded & in time they will be given to the Union County Historical Society Museum where they can be available for researchers. There are regular forms and procedures - laws - that have to be followed to the letter before public records of any kind can be destroyed or removed from the office- so it isn't up to the office holders alone - these moves take time and much work.

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
