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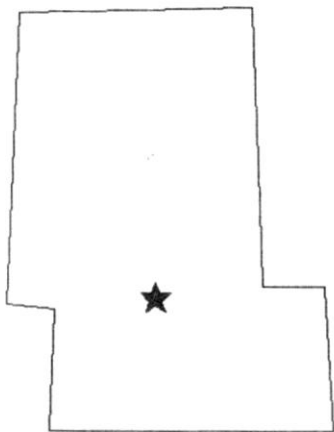

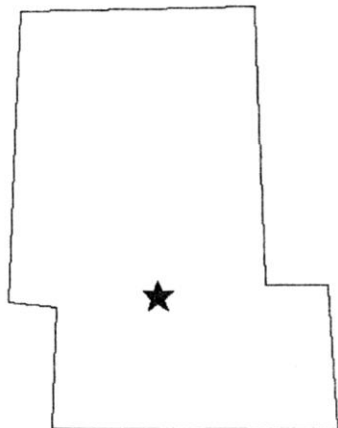

"Some of the members before the turn of the century were: Henry & Abby Pence, Jennie Brown, Rufus Creviston, Thomas Coons, Nelson & Loutitia Thornton, George & Mary Coons, John Cahill, Jess & Mary Fisher, Ora Fisher, Samuel Sherwood, Harley Thornton, Andrew & Lillie Middlesworth, Mary Robinson, Julia Robinson, Jennie Moore, David Fisher, Maddie Speece, Ivan Spring and many, many others. Ministers during this time were Stuart Noble, Adelia Fistler, Minnie Basset, Ezra Basset, Ezra Pierson, Calvin Straton, Sarah Healy, Mary Coons, Maude Milliner Hoskins, J. Smith." 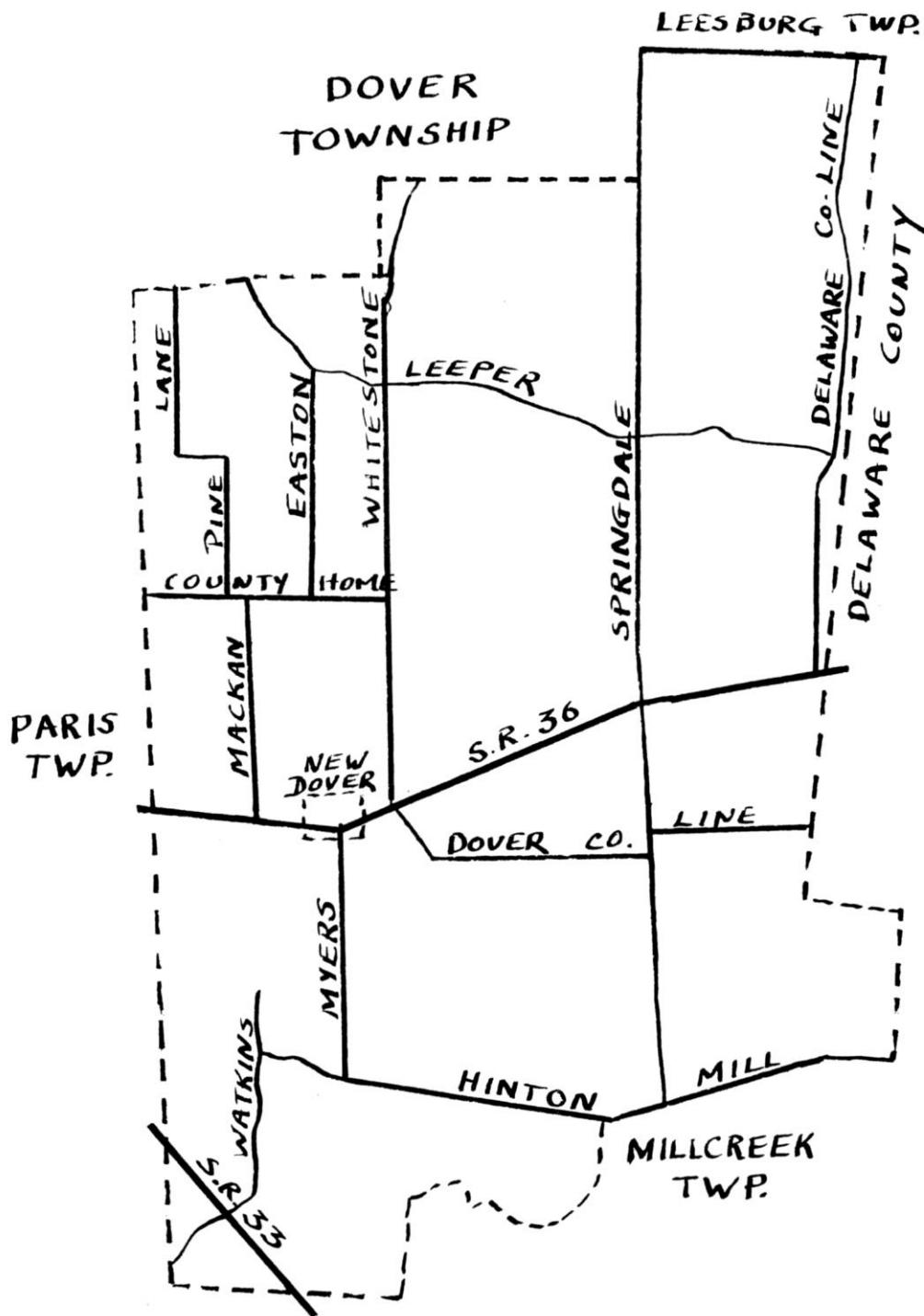

In the fall of 1839 they moved to Noble County Indiana where three of their children were born. About 15 years later they returned to Toledo where the rest of the children were born. Since that time they have lived in Lansing. In August of 1888 they went to Ridgfield N.J. to live with their daughter, Mrs. W.B. Pugh. Rebecca died February 1st 1894.

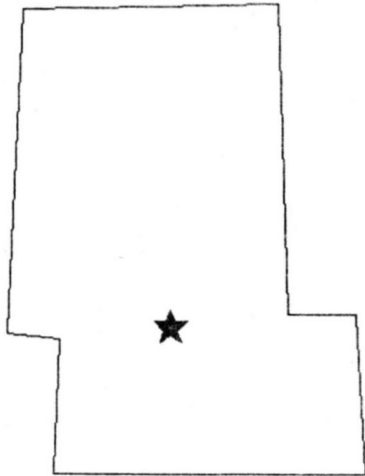
19 February 1879 Rev. J.C. Jackson was the recipient of a fine baby on Sunday last. Charley Van Harlingen, ditto, on Friday last.

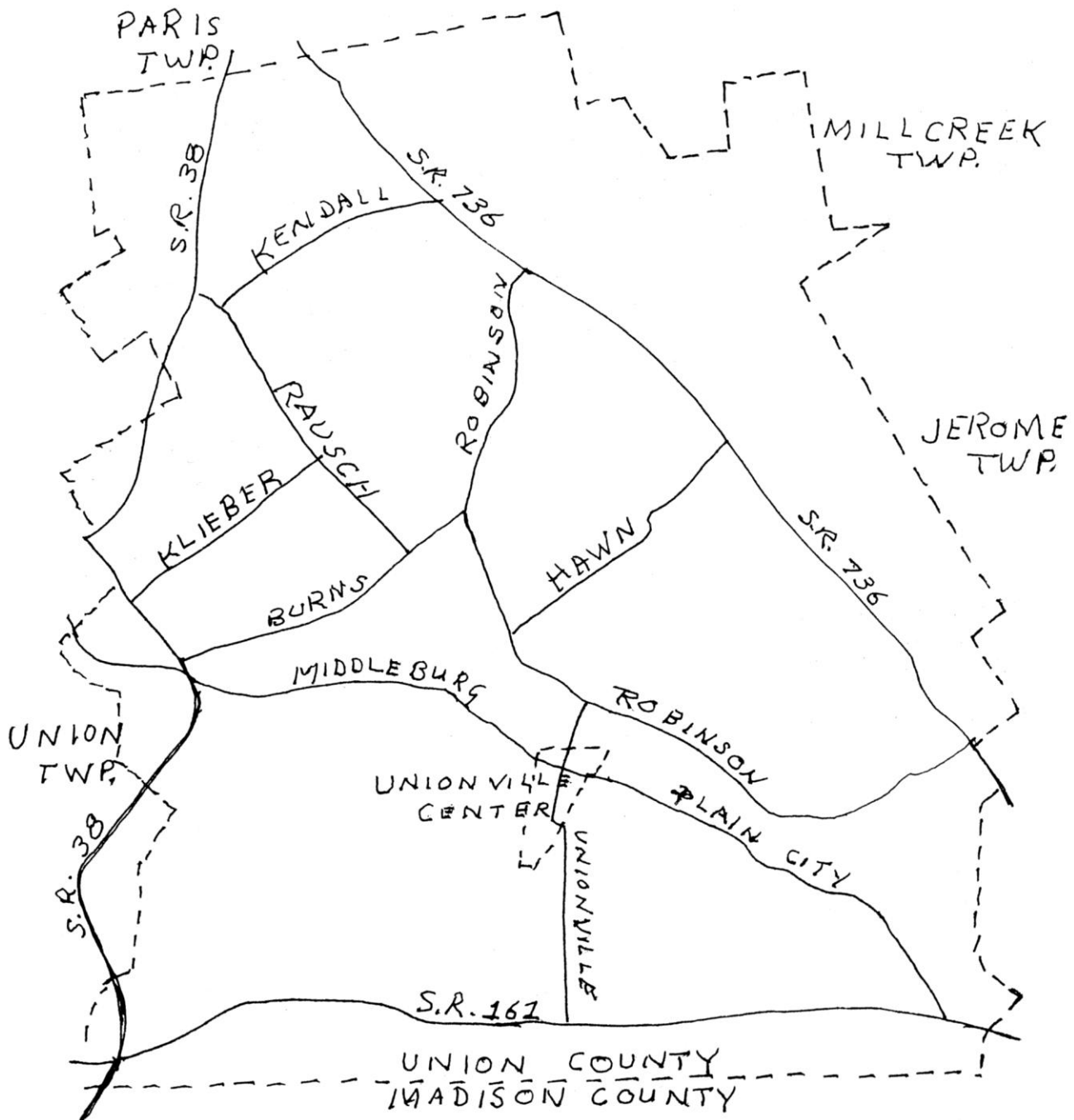

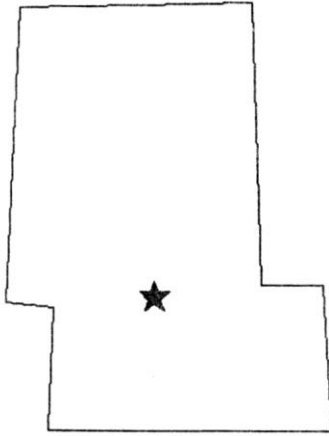

called. Sometimes remote rural areas were not reached.

Sometimes the taker missed names because of laziness, neglect or  
drunkeness. Many times the taker spelled phonetically or guessed at  
the spelling. (Researchers have to hunt every possible spelling & many  
times

(the impossible spelling is the clue.)

Sometimes the taker wrote poorly, used own style of writing, got ink  
blots or smears or watered the ink & it faded.

Sometimes pages were damaged, tape repairs, improper bindery work or  
low quality photography destroyed the information.

Sometimes names were omitted when the census takers made copies for the  
state and county governments.

Then there is the Census Indexes - most of the above applies to the  
misreading in those indexes too.

(In spite of all the above problems - we are most grateful for the  
Census Records and for the Census Takers.)

A MESSAGE FROM YOUR CHAPTER PRESIDENT  
OHIO CHURCH RECORD SURVEY

You know how important church records are. Often they are the earliest "vital records" available, and as genealogists, where would we be without them?

The Ohio Genealogical Society has asked each chapter in the state to participate in the Ohio Church Record Survey. The purpose is to locate all churches, even those that no longer exist, and provide informed access to their records. A secondary purpose is to bring to churches' attention the importance of preserving records through improved storage or microfilming. We will not be removing any records from churches although we would like to personally see the available records.

At the end of the project, we will have access to a data base that can be searched by county, denomination, etc. Our chapter will receive a list of churches and records for our county that we can publish if we wish.

Each church or congregation will be visited by a chapter member or other interested party. Michael Clegg of the Fort Wayne, Indiana library is serving as project coordinator and has prepared a questionnaire that all surveyors will use.

Here is how you can help.

First, we need a list of Union County churches. Do you know of any churches that were once in Union County but no longer exist? If you know of a contact person for that congregation, that would be especially helpful.

Second, we need surveyors. This is a big project! There must be at least seventy-five churches in Union County not to mention those that no longer exist. If we each survey one or two churches, the burden will not fall to just one or two.

This is the project for you. Every chapter member living in or near Union County can help. It is not only necessary, but I think it can be a lot of fun. Please get in touch with me to volunteer for "the church of your choice."

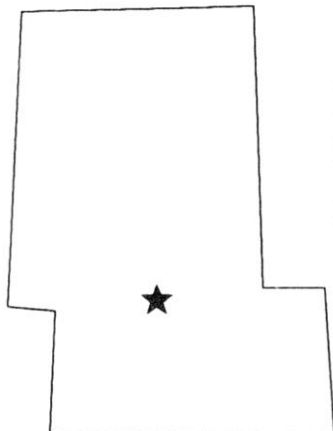

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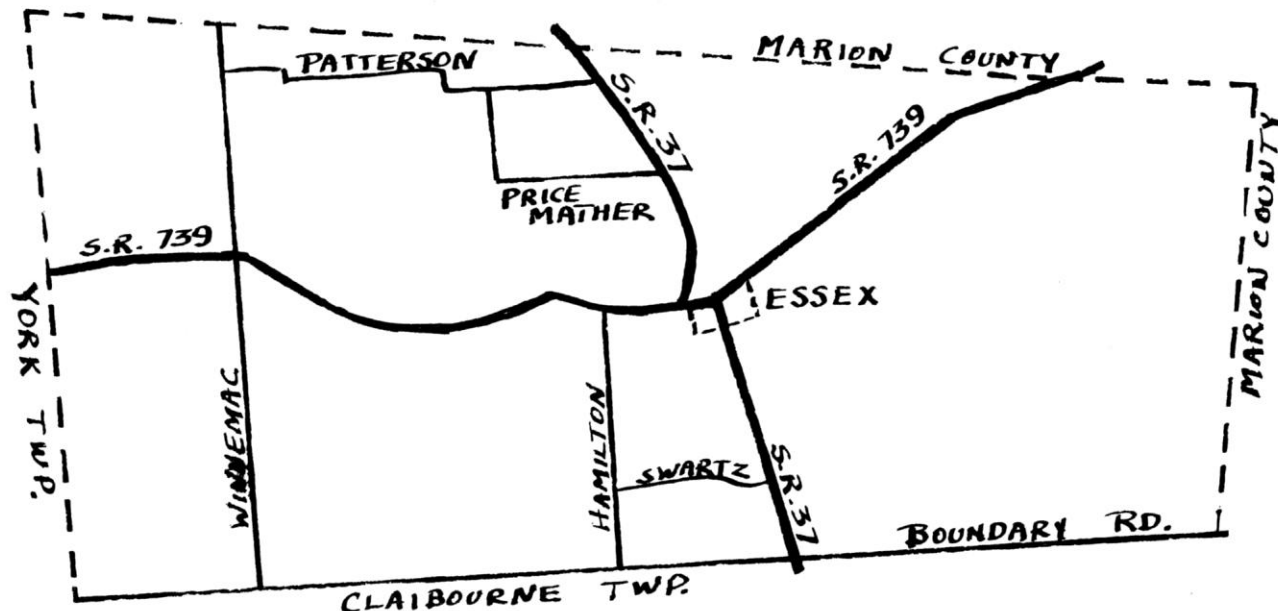
